This permit is issued under the following specific conditions and the applicant agrees that upon approval of this application:

- Applicant shall assume full responsibility for control of the burning herein applied and the liability for damages, loss of property, injury and death or government expenses that may result from this burning. This includes penalties resulting from the violations of the laws, ordinances and rules of the Midway Fire District, Santa Rosa County, Florida State, or Federal Agencies.
- Applicant shall indemnify and hold harmless the Midway Fire District from and against loss, cost and expense including attorney's fees, claims, suits and judgments whatsoever in connection with injury to or death of any person(s) or loss of or damages to property caused by or in any way connected with the burning applied for herein.

Applicant shall ensure that:

- An attendant is present at all times during the burning and until he himself has assured that the fire is completely extinguished.
- The fire will be completely extinguished should Midway Fire District determine it necessary.
- The wind is favorable and will not carry smoke or ash onto neighbor's clothing, vehicle(s), home or property.
- Only land clearing materials shall be burned. Trash, tires, structural materials and such shall be removed.
- Burning shall not commence prior to 8:00 am and must be dead out no later than one hour before sunset.
- Applicant shall contact Midway Fire District at (850) 932-4771 each morning for permission to burn prior to igniting the fire.
- Applicant, applicant's company and their employees must meet the burning requirements specified by the Division of Forestry and the Environmental Protection Agency, including, but not limited to setback requirements.

Midway Fire District or the Division of Forestry may activate a burn ban as necessary. This permit will be suspended at that time.
 Failure to comply with all of the above may result in loss of present and future burning privileges and/or fines, imprisonment and / or bills for services rendered.
